## **Administrator for the Charity**

Following the retirement of the Charity's current post-holder, a vacancy has arisen for the post of Administrator for *Being Alongside*, also known as the Association for Pastoral Care in Mental Health.

The charity was formed in 1986 by the parents of a son who was living with serious and long-term mental ill-health, in order to educate and campaign for effective and appropriate spiritual care at a time when little was available or even understood within the mental health context. In the ensuing 35 years, local initiatives have offered drop-ins, one-to-one befriending schemes, art, spirituality and creative writing groups, together with national and local seminars and conferences to raise the profile of spirituality and mental health.
